

Outline for Summer Research Powerpoint Pt. I

Your powerpoint should include pictures, diagrams, maps, charts and not more than 10 words per slide. The pictures support what you will be saying as you present. The slides should be done artistically – they should look nice and be “easy on the eyes”. You can embed videos and use stock pictures but make sure that they support your point of view.

- Cover page . . . what the project is about, date, school, class, your name
- Intro . . . you and your school experience (a couple of pictures of you in elementary school would be great)
- School memories . . . outings, trips, events
- Argument for changing the way we do school
 - How did our school system start – what is its foundation?
 - How does Education work in Canada? Who makes the decisions?
 - What is wrong with our school system?
 - What needs to change?
 - List 5 priorities for change
 - Why should we change it?
 - Elementary / High school differences
- How did people learn before there were schools?
- What is the power structure in schools?
 - Who wins? Who loses?
 - How has colonialism shaped how/what we learn?
- Intro . . . what is Land-based pedagogy?
- What is the difference between:
 - Going for a walk with your class
 - School outing
 - Place-based education
 - Land-based education
 - Forest schools
- Examples of Land-based education schools (2 or 3)
- How they work (examples)
- Pros / cons
