Dear parent(s),

Doesn't this warmer weather make you long for summer? We're almost there!

Just a few reminders as the school year winds down:

This is a critical time in the school year. If your child MUST miss classes for an appointment s/he will miss teaching/learning which will undoubtedly affect his/her grades. So much important learning happens in the dynamic environment of the classroom! Please try to use PED days and after school for appointments.

The May/June exam schedule is posted on the website. The times and dates are dictated by the Ministry of Education of Quebec. We also have no control over the content of the exams. Students must be in their chairs before the exam begins otherwise they forfeit the thrill of writing the exam! This is also a Ministry of Education regulation.

COVID is omnipresent and constantly mutating. We are doing our best to keep your child safe. We have CO₂ meters in all our classrooms, and we open windows when we go beyond acceptable limits. We have a new ventilation system, and we spend a lot of time outdoors. Masks are still being worn when we move around the school. If your child presents with COVID-like symptoms – test him/her. If they test positive, the student must stay at home. S/he should consult the website to do as much homework as possible without the benefit of instruction. If a student is unable to write an exam due to COVID, s/he can register for summer school exams.

As the weather gets warmer and exams get closer, students get a little more anxious. This anxiety can produce unexpected and unacceptable behaviour. Please work with us as we intervene and try to prevent academic and social disasters. We have all worked too hard this year to let this happen! We really love your children and together we can set them up for success.
